Getting Started

Welcome to our Session Overview! This guide aims to provide you with all the essential details about our exciting program. We have something for everyone to embark on a thrilling journey of learning, creativity, and self-expression.

This program is designed to allow dancers to participate in a shorter session with a small in studio presentation. The recital session allows dancer to be part of the big show on June, 1, 2024 at Westbrook Performing Arts Center.

<u>Tuition</u>

Tuition is charged per session and is due at the time of registration. Once you sign up for the session, your card will automatically be charged. If you sign up for multiple sessions, you will be charged at the beginning of each session. If you sign up for all sessions, you will receive a 10% discount on your last session.

You are able to see all of your transactions through your <u>Akada account</u>. Payments can be made when you log into your account at any time.



Fall 23/24 Pricing

Registration Fee: \$25.00 per student or \$40.00 per family in same household. Registration fees are non-refundable and you will only be charged one registration per school year.

Sessions Pricing

Each session has different dates and are priced per dancer with the exception of Grown Up and Me. Grown Up and Me is priced per household in the session.

<u>Schedules</u>

Scheduling options are listed in the Session Schedule tab on our website. You may choose which scheduling option works best for you, pending availability.

Once enrolled, students will remain in the same class throughout the session. Dancers should try

to avoid missing more than three (3) classes per session. At the end of all non-recital sessions dancers will show what they learned during an in studio performance at the end of class.

Class Attire

Visit the SHOP <u>tab</u> on our website to view our online store for your dance wear needs this season. Female dancers should wear a leotard, tights with optional shorts or skirts for class. Acro dancers should not wear tights to class. Male dancers should wear plain black or white tight fitted clothing. All dance shoes are to be purchased either at the studio or through our online store. Dancers must have the correct shoes for our recital at the end of the year if they participate in the last session.

Costume and Recital Fee Payments

The only session that will participate in the recital is the Recital Showcase session. Costumes are 75.00 each. All recital costume and recital fee payments are due when you register for the Recital Showcase session, it will be placed on your account and will automatically be charged to the card on file when you sign up. All late payments will incur a \$5.00 per week late fee. We appreciate your on time payment to ensure all of the classes' costumes will be ordered on time. Costumes and tights are non-refundable. The recital fee (\$35) goes towards the end of the year recital video. You will receive a link to the recital video that you can share with friends and family. Your dancers will also receive a recital pin to commemorate the season.
