Recital Cheat Sheets-We will be printing off Recital Cheat Sheets for every dancer over the next week and a half. The sheets have dress rehearsal day/time and what number they are in the recital. We will also let you know when to report backstage.

Betsy, Trish and I will be handing them out to parents and dancers if/when we see you, or stop by the desk if you are there. Teachers will also be handing them out to the dancers at the end of class.

Dress Rehearsal Note-All dancers should plan to arrive 30 minutes prior to their stage time and expect to stay 30-40 minutes after stage time to have their photo taken with their class.

Below is a guide for hair and makeup. Unless your child has been given other specific instructions by their teacher. Please use the following as a helpful guide if you are wondering what hair your child should have for recital/dress rehearsal.

Makeup:

Creative Movement Classes-Light blush and lipstick. No eye makeup and no glitter please.

Level 1 & 2 Classes (ages 5-10yrs)-Light eye makeup (brown towns only, no glitter), blush and lipstick. Mascara optional.

All Dancers ages 11-up-foundation, mascara, light eye makeup (brown tones only, no glitter), blush and lipstick.

Jewelry-No jewelry unless it is part of the costume. If a dancer is wearing non-costume jewelry they will be asked to remove the jewelry. Please note: Dance Studio of Maine is NOT responsible for any worn/removed jewelry.

This information is very important so please look over carefully and use as a reference!
